

Regulation for the registration and application of disciplinary actions

1. General provisions

1.1 Yellow and red cards (hereinafter - cards) are shown to HMBIA fighters in accordance to the rules and regulations of the competition.

1.2 Cards received at competitions of national branches (National Federations) of HMBIA are taken into account when holding tournaments of this branch

1.3 Cards received at the Buhurt League competitions are to be counted at all Buhurt League competitions, regardless of the venue.

1.4 Cards received at the Battle of the Nations, as well as at other international events listed on the special HMBIA list, are to be taken into account at all HMBIA events.

1.5 The HMBIA management has the exclusive right to decide to take into account the cards at any HMBIA tournaments. For example, if a fighter received a card at the national championship, the HMBIA management can demand that the card to be taken into account in Buhurt league tournaments.

2. Accounting cards in the disciplines

2.1 Accounting cards are conducted separately in the following disciplines:

2.1.1 all buhurt nominations;

2.1.2 all duel nominations;

2.1.3 full contact medieval battles (professional fights);

2.1.4 other disciplines, if any.

2.2 At the Battle of the Nations, as well as at some other events, a cross-cutting accumulation of the cards is kept (cards are added up, regardless of the discipline in which they were received).

3. Yellow card

3.1 Yellow cards remain on the fighter's name for the entirety of the tournament season. The tournament season is determined according to the schedules of the HMBIA, Buhurt League, or the National Federation, depending at which event the yellow card was received.

3.2 If during a season a fighter receives three yellow cards then he misses the next tournament in which his team participates. Yellow cards received for inauthentic appearance or technical mismatch of equipment are not counted. Accumulated yellow cards are reset after the forfeited tournament.

3.3 In case of the second occurrence of situation described above during the same season, the fighter receives a red card.

3.4 Yellow cards received at the previous event are counted in the overall history of the fighter, but not cumulated with the ones received in a particular tournament. So, if a fighter already had a yellow card at the last tournament and he gets the next one - this does not lead to disqualification at the event itself.

4. Red card

4.1 The red card is retained for 90 days from the date of receiving. The day of receiving is considered the first day. Day of the card withdrawal - the day after the 90 days period is concluded.

4.2 The fighter who has received the red card is to be suspended from participating in competitions of the appropriate level and discipline for three months. This fighter can not be included to the team application. Three months are taken into account, if during this period the team of the fighter who received the red card participates in tournaments of the appropriate level and discipline. Otherwise, the fighter is considered to be disqualified for

the next competition, in which his team participates (even if they take place after the specified period).

4.3 In the case of individual disciplines, three months are counted if in the region (conditional regions: Western Europe, Eastern Europe, North America, South America, China-Australia-New Zealand) of a fighter, corresponding competitions were held. If within the specified time limit there are no such competitions, the fighter will be disqualified for the next competition (even if they take place after the specified time limit).

4.4 Features of the application of this rule for Buhurt League.

4.4.1 If within three months from the day the fighter receives a red card, his team does not participate in any tournament, the fighter is considered to be disqualified for the next tournament of the OPEN or MASTERS level in which his team participates.

4.4.2 If during the three-month period the team of a disqualified fighter participates in a tournament of the OPEN or MASTERS level, the card is withdrawn immediately after the tournament.

4.5 If a fighter, who has already received a red card, receives the same one again within the calendar year after the previous one has been expired, then the time of the penalty period increases from 6 months to a year by decision of the National Federation.

4.6 If a fighter receives a red card within a calendar year after the second red card has been expired, the HMBIA management has the right to disqualify the fighter for life.

4.7 The decision on each red card is mandatorily reviewed by the control and disciplinary commission of the appropriate level.
