

Regulation on the HMBIA Control and Disciplinary Committee

Article 1. Control and Disciplinary Committee (CDC)

1.1 Control and Disciplinary Committee is a structural unit of the organization HMBIA

1.2 The Control and Disciplinary Committee, settles sports labor disputes, disciplinary and other disputes arising in the field of “HMBIA” activities, by considering them, resolving and motivating for voluntary execution or forcing them to execute decisions and definitions.

1.3 The Control and Disciplinary Committee approves or revises all long-term disciplinary measures applied to athletes in accordance with the HMBIA Regulations.

1.4 The Control and Disciplinary Committee cannot interfere into the activities of the Marshal Committee or review the decisions of the marshals adopted during the competition.

Article 2. Tasks of the Control and Disciplinary Committee

The tasks of the Control and Disciplinary Committee are the fair, correct and prompt consideration and resolution of disputes. Proceedings in the Control and Disciplinary Committee should help strengthen the sporting law and order and prevent violations.

Article 3. Regulations used by the control and disciplinary committee in its activities

In its activities, the Control and Disciplinary Committee is guided by the the Rules, Regulations of the HMBIA and other regulatory legal acts without restrictions.

Article 4. The composition of the Control and Disciplinary Committee

4.1 The Control and Disciplinary Committee consists of the Chairman, one Vice-Chairman and at least 3 (three) members of the Control and Disciplinary Committee suggested by Board and approved by President for a period of 1 year. President and Head of Marshals committee are included in CDC automatically as Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

4.2 In the case of the temporary absence of the Chairman of the Control and Disciplinary Committee, his duties for this period are performed by the Vice-Chairman. In case of early termination of the authority of the Chairman of the Control and Disciplinary Committee, his duties are performed by the Vice-Chairman until the appointment of a new Chairman of the Control and Disciplinary Committee in the prescribed manner.

4.3 The members of the Control and Disciplinary Committee may be individuals who have a deserved authority, positive business reputation and a civil position, as well as possessing the necessary knowledge for a comprehensive, objective and independent resolution of disputes related to the competence of the Control and Disciplinary Committee. Members of the Control and Disciplinary Committee must be included in the list of members of the Control and Disciplinary Committee.

4.4 Only a member of the Control and Disciplinary Committee included in the list of Control and Disciplinary Committee may resolve a dispute.

Article 5. The activities of the Control and Disciplinary Committee, the order of cases

5.1 Control and Disciplinary Committee meets in the event that intervention is requested.

5.2 The reason for opening a session of the Control and Disciplinary Committee may be: making an assessment of “disqualification” - about a red card to an athlete or team, a statement or misbehavior by an athlete, club, team or other person who is a member of HMBIA.

5.3 The application is submitted in writing to the HMBIA President with a request to consider this one at the session of the Control and Disciplinary Committee. The application has to contain the full contact details of the applicant, the statement of the matter on the merits. The burden of providing evidence for the consideration of the application rests entirely with the applicant.

5.4 Meetings (sessions) of the Control and Disciplinary Committee are held behind closed doors.

5.5 At the time of the meeting, a secretary is elected from among the members of the Control and Disciplinary Committee. The secretary takes minutes of the meeting, prepares a final decision of the control and disciplinary Committee.

5.6 A session of the Control and Disciplinary Committee is considered to be legit in the presence of all members of the Committee.

5.7 If there is no possibility of a face-to-face meeting, it is possible to hold an absentee session of the Control and Disciplinary Committee using remote communication tools (Skype, Messenger on Facebook, etc.)

5.8 In case of emergency, a meeting of the Control and Disciplinary Committee may be incomplete. In this case, special coordination with the HMBIA President and Council is required.

5.9 The Control and Disciplinary Committee takes a decision by voting, by defining a simple majority of votes. In the event that a simple majority of votes cannot be determined, (equal number of votes for each decision) the vote of the Chairman of the Control and Disciplinary Committee is decisive.

5.10 Deadlines for processing: for "red cards" - no more than 14 calendar days from the date of end of the competition; for the applications - no more than 30 calendar days from the date of the application.

5.11 A short summary of the hearing and the outcome detailing the parties involved and the nature of the circumstances can be made public through official channels. The Committee reserves the right not to publish details in exceptional circumstances.
